Dear Parents/Carers

It has been a great first week back, with children sharing news of their Diwali celebrations and exploring Diwali further in their RE lessons. Children have also been excited about celebrating many other aspects of the Autumn season and have brought their autumnal art projects into school as part of a PTA competition, which has been lovely to see!

Next week, we will mark Remembrance on Monday 11th November across the school, with two minutes of silent reflection, to mark this important event, as well as holding assemblies led by Mrs Sahota. Along with other schools in Coventry, Year 6 attended the Children's Remembrance Service at the Memorial Park this week and it allowed them to think about the impact and sacrifice of war linked to their Rising From The Rubble creative curriculum topic, which they are currently studying. Councillor Mal Mutton, Lord Mayor of Coventry, has asked schools in Coventry to share this message to make you aware of commemorations:

The Remembrance Day Service and Parade will be held on Sunday, 10th November 2024 at 10.30 am in the War Memorial Park.

I know that schools already support the work of the Royal British Legion through the wearing of poppies, the symbol of Remembrance at this time, which is very appropriate to ensure our next generation understand the importance of the occasion.

Each year the service ensures that memories of ex-service men and women from WW1, WW2 and more recent wars are not forgotten. We would like the children of our city, and their families, to share in this year's event.

Next week, we also have an important focus on anti-bullying, when we will be learning about 'Choosing Respect'. Mrs Hart will be leading assemblies on how to disagree respectfully as part of this important nationwide campaign and this will be followed up in class, through discussions in PSHE. Odd Socks Day for Anti-bullying Week is on Tuesday, where we all join together to think about inclusivity and kindness, and when we celebrate that we are all different and all equal.

Children in Need is on Friday 15th November and we will be joining in the fun and fundraising by wearing our Pudsey ears and t-shirts as part of our school uniform that day. We would kindly ask for the children to bring in donations towards this very worthwhile charity event please.

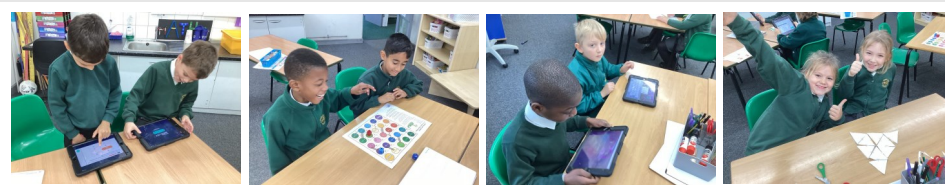
