Dear Parents/Carers

We have had a busy week in school with some fantastic WOW events taking place! Year 5 looked amazing in their Egyptian outfits and had a fun-filled day learning all about Ancient Egypt. It was also lovely to see the array of superheroes and real life heroes the Year 1s transformed into for their Superhumans topic. All the teachers looked the part too!

We have been very impressed with children's learning as we've visited classrooms this week. There is an important focus on developing and elevating oracy skills, both learning to talk and learning through talk, as part of our Voice 21 programme. Children are learning to listen more effectively and are showing great enthusiasm for using different talk tactics.

We are eagerly awaiting the results of the year group Junior Leadership Team representatives, which should be declared next week. We also now have our house captains from Year 6 in place - huge congratulations to them!

And just a few reminders...

Manor Park is a nut-free school so please refrain from sending lunches into school that contain nuts as we need to protect children and adults in our school community who are allergic to them.

In school, we teach children about eating a healthy, balanced diet and promote this as much as we can.
