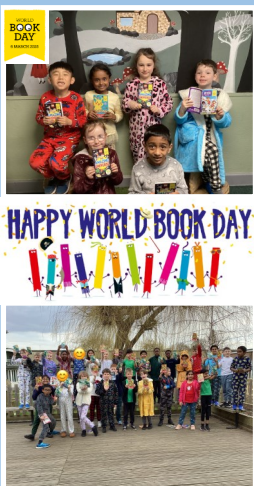


## Reminders
