Dear Parents/Carers

This week, we have been learning about neurodiversity, as it is Neurodiversity Celebration Week. Children have engaged in lessons and an assembly by Mrs Shepherd on challenging stereotypes and misconceptions about neurodevelopmental conditions and learning disabilities. At Manor Park, we celebrate different minds and the skills and talents that neurodiversity can bring with it. We believe in empowering all our pupils so learning about our differences and the strengths that these can offer our school community is really important to us.

Earth Watch Tiny Forest Project have invited some of our pupils to plant trees in the local area. Year 5 have been chosen to join in with this important project and will be joining Earth Watch next Thursday. We are very happy at Manor Park to support this initiative in improving our environment.

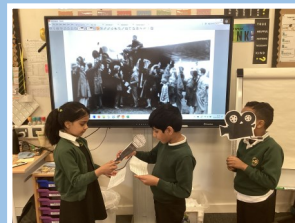
