Dear Parents/Carers

Children and staff have had lots of fun today dressing up for the NSPCC Number Day - we had some wonderful Times Tables Rockstars and Numberblocks outfits on display! It is the 25th anniversary of this mega maths fundraising day, in aid of raising money for the NSPCC charity and for Childline, and we are very happy to support it. Thank you for all your donations to this worthy cause.

As a school, we have been introducing and embedding teaching and learning of oracy through our Voice 21 programme. We believe that every child's voice is important and should be valued, so we are focusing on 'learning to talk' and 'learning through talk'. Children are enjoying becoming more confident in speaking and listening and developing strategies to become more successful orators. Early Years have been focusing on the building blocks of oracy this week and it is lovely to see our youngest learners acquiring and practising new vocabulary and sentence stems.

Well done to Class 18 for a wonderful class assembly today - the children put on a very confident performance!

We would like to make parents aware that police forces across the country are running **Operation Snap** in a drive to improve road safety. Members of the public can report traffic offences directly to the police team by submitting digital footage, or images (if they capture the offence) via the website [Operation Snap | West Midlands Police](https://www.operation-snap.co.uk/). All footage and images are reviewed and police action is taken where appropriate. The only important criteria is that it must be submitted as soon as possible and definitely within 10 days. This is because the police have to notify the driver of any intended prosecution within 14 days of the offence. Unfortunately, we have had some incidents of dangerous or inconsiderate driving in the area outside school, where a child could potentially have been hurt, so if you do see what you believe to be a traffic offence, please report on Operation Snap. Thank you.
